#### **Spellings for Me:**

We have taken on a new spelling programme from  $2^{nd}$  to  $6^{th}$  class called "**Spellings For Me**". This is an individualised spelling programme where the children's spellings are differentiated according to individual ability - tailor-made spellings for each child.

"Spellings For Me" is an online and an offline programme. The online aspect is the child's profile where they log in and take a series of tests. When the teachers are satisfied with the child's progress, they will give permission for the child to continue online at home.

We are very excited about this new programme and the children's response has been very positive.
